

Social and Economic Need

A variety of employment sources, including pubs, take-aways, shops, a hotel, a restaurant, a service station and an electronics factory, are found along the current route of the A51 (Main Road Brereton and Brereton Road Ravenhill). The Brereton Business Park contains a wide variety of businesses, including engineering, scaffolding, metal-finishing, motor services, the manufacture of embroidery kits, garden machinery, tools servicing, sign-making and monumental masonry. There are a number of larger vacant industrial properties there, which, together with smaller units currently under construction, will offer opportunities for more new and varied jobs.

The Parish needs jobs that provide a career path for local young people and contribute significantly to the enhancement of the local economy.



The Towers Business Park already accommodates a wide range of modern premises and successful companies. These provide a variety of businesses, including distribution, document-recovery, a fitness centre, financial services, battery supplies and other industrial and service activities. The newly built Towers Plaza has been developed to a high standard and will provide accommodation for more quality firms offering employment opportunities. Land at the Business Park still remains available for development. The soon-to-be-completed Rugeley By-pass will render these sites more attractive to investment, as will the proposed improvements to the M6 to Manchester. They will, we hope, soon accommodate new premises, including at least one major employer, provide many hundreds of jobs (including jobs that provide a career path for local young people) and contribute significantly to the enhancement of the local economy.
